Tourism Whitsundays CEO, Rick Hamilton said the addition of a place for local artists to exhibit their work is a great addition to The Whitsundays.

'When we look at the offering of The Whitsundays, art is something that is missing a lot of the year, the new gallery space will give art a home all year,' Mr Hamilton said.

3 Little Birds co-owner and artist, Joan Hunter said the gallery showing was the result of a lot of hard work put in by the 3 Little Birds team and Angela Vivian.

'Our goal is to add a year-round arts attraction to The Whitsundays, this first showing is just the start!' said Ms Hunter.

3 Little Birds Gallery will be open to the public from Saturday 5 and Saturday 6 November 10am - 2pm. An exclusive viewing on Friday 4 November will give ticket holders the opportunity to purchase the art works on show, meet with the artists and enjoy music by Lucy Sherrington.
