The company also runs school-based Coxswain's courses and a variety of Eco and Edu-tourism-tailored tours, including the curriculum-based 'Immersive Learning Project', designed to foster 'travel for good' and broaden stewardship of the Great Barrier Reef.

With the tag-line "your ride, your adventure", Whitsunday Jetski Tours offers the daily 1.5-hour Airlie Adventure Tour, two-hour Two Island Safari and four-hour Ultimate Trek, visiting Long Island's Palm Bay.
