# Excitement brewing in Bowen for The Whitsundays' Don River Dash 300

Action-packed bikes, cars and trophy trucks event: 8-10 September 2023

The 2023 Don River Dash kicks-off on Friday 8 September, when hundreds of bikes, cars and trophy trucks will descend on the streets of Bowen in The Whitsundays for the fifth-annual <u>Don River Dash</u> festival race event.

Inspired by the best courses in the world, the Don River Dash is the only two-day off-road race that sees bikes, cars and trophy trucks race a reverse grid format through a multi-terrain natural course.

Open to professionals and hobby-riders, the Don River Dash is a family-friendly event, and entry is FREE for spectators.

Opening day festivities from 5pm-9pm at the Bowen Showgrounds will feature live music from local favourite Mike Vaughan, a come-and-try Yamaha PW50 motorbike experience for kids aged 4-7 years, and the opportunity to meet with drivers and riders and get an up-close look at their vehicles. Don River Dash Eat Street will also be in full swing with everything from light refreshments to tantalising South American BBQ.

This year's nomination numbers have thus far tipped more than 100 in the car divisions. In bikes, almost 250 have nominated, with 43 bikes in the Masters over 45 years division, and 12 nominated in the Ladies Division. Of the 246 nominations for bikes, only 9 are semi pro or pro-riders, with the remainder falling in the amateur or beginner categories.

Don River Dash co-founder and President Michael Marson, gave his comment from, America's longest offroad point-to-point race, Vegas to Reno, and said, 'In our 5th year we are excited for all competitors to experience unique offroad racing in the true natural terrain in one of the most beautiful parts of Australia.'

Legendary off-road racer and VIP Experience owner, Ben 'Grabbo' Grabham has made the Don River Dash a permanent race in the VIP Experience calendar, after Grabbo competed in the Dash for the first time last year.

'Our customers come from all over Australia; they can fly in, race a bike, and then spend the rest of the week as a tourist. There are not too many places in the world where you can experience the thrill and speed of a desert-like race event in a setting as spectacular as The Whitsundays. The event format and the laid-back nature of the local community make it a must-do for any rev-heads that want to combine racing with a tropical holiday,' Ben Grabham said.

Tourism Whitsundays CEO, Rick Hamilton added: "The Whitsundays is renowned for our beautiful beaches and reef and it's fantastic to see events like the Don River Dash drawing huge visitor interest from across Australia.

"Crowds of more than 5000 are expected this year, and we're all revved-up to watch the races over the weekend and enjoy the Friday night festivities.

"Undoubtedly now the pinnacle off-road racing event in Queensland, the Don River Dash has firmly put The Whitsundays on the map of Australian motorsports. It's truly very exciting," Rick Hamilton added.
